Within the framework of the liquidity agreement (see press release dated July 29, 2021), Elia Group reports today that Exane BNP Paribas on behalf of Elia Group has purchased 7,680 Elia Group shares during the period between 16 September 2024 and 20 September 2024 on Euronext Brussels. During the same period, Exane BNP Paribas on behalf of Elia Group has sold 3,900 Elia Group shares.
